Erratum

Reid, C.A.M. (2006) A taxonomic revision of the Australian Chrysomelinae, with a key to the genera (Coleoptera: Chrysomelidae), *Zootaxa*, 1292, 1–119.

Two significant errors have come to light since the publication of this monograph on 14 August 2006, one functional, one factual.

(i) As published the key does not work because of two couplet-number errors. The following corrections are required:

21(20)	Apical maxillary etc	22
-	Apical maxillary etc	25 [not 24]
23(22)	Prosternal process etc	24 [not 23]
-	Prosternal process etc	Paropsis aspera

(ii) Figure 31 shows a South American specimen of *Calligrapha polyspila* (Germar), not the species introduced to Australia, *C. pantherina* Stål. The latter is similarly patterned (including sutural stripe) and shaped but is smaller and has spots more irregular in shape and dissimilar in size.
