# A new species of the genus *Iiella* Băcescu, 1968 (Crustacea: Mysida: Mysidae) from Malaysia, with notes on *I. elegans* (Tattersall, 1960)

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#### **Abstract**

*Iiella malayensis* **sp. nov.** from Malaysian waters is described here. This species is distinguished from related species by the shape of the rostral plate, the number and length of the subsegments of the first exopodal segment of the third male pleopod, the number of spines on the labrum, the number of spiniform setae on the lateral margin of the telson, and the position of the anterior end of the apical cleft of the telson. Supplemental taxonomic notes on *I. elegans* (Tattersall, 1960) based on type specimens are provided. A key to the species of *Iiella* is provided.

### Introduction

The genus *Iiella* Băcescu, 1968 was established to accommodate species separated from *Gastrosaccus* Norman, 1868 on the basis of the characteristics of the labrum and pleopods as follows: the labrum has a long, median, frontal process and several short, acute processes on the each side of it; all pleopods of female are uniramous; and the endopod of the third male pleopod is multi-articulated. It currently comprises eight species (Mees 2010), which are distributed in East Asian and Southeast Asian waters (Table 1).
