

Correction to "A description of four new species of *Clavicornaltica* Scherer from Continental Asia"

We recently published descriptions of four species of *Clavicornaltica* Scherer from Continental Asia (Konstantinov and Duckett 2005). These species were compared to known species including *Clavicornaltica australis* Konstantinov. Due to an unfortunate event the figure showing the male genitalia of *C. australis* was omitted. This figure shown below (Fig. 1) is cited in the discussion on page 62 as figure 32.
