***Galkinius* nom.nov., replacement name for *Galkinia* Ross & Newman, 1995**

In 1995, Ross & Newman proposed *Galkinia* as a replacement name for *Utinomia* Galkin, 1986 (Cirripedia: Pyrgomatidae), which was pre-occupied. However, this author discovered *Galkinia* was itself pre-occupied by a genus of fossil fish, *Galkinia* Ghekker, 1948 (Actinopterygii: Pholidophoriformes).

Galkinius is herein proposed as a replacement name for *Galkinia* Ross & Newman, 1995, to preserve the recognition of S.V. Galkin's contributions to our knowledge of cirripeds. The type species is *Pyrgoma indicum* Annandale, 1924.
