The full sentences in the line 4–6 at page 158 should be “*S. yapensis* **sp. nov.** has the fewest number and the most degraded form of cribriform organ within the genus, which might as well be an adaptive strategy for its life in the great deep sea. (\**S. monacanthus* was described to have “5 narrow cribriform organs” in each interradius in the original descriptions (Ludwig, 1907, p315; H. L. Clark, 1920, p80), but mistakenly recorded by Madsen (1961, p123) as having 7 cribriform organs.)”
