On page 4, the numbering of the three last couplets need to be corrected as follows:

- 38(37). Elytral apex obliquely truncate or subrounded (Figs. 24–26) *Neoeutrypanus* Monné, 1977 (part)
- Elytral apex truncate with outer angle slightly projected (Fig. 8) *Carphina* Bates, 1872

- 39(37). Humeral carina present (Figs. 24–26) *Neoeutrypanus* Monné, 1977 (part)
- Humeral carina absent 40
- Obs.: *Neoeutrypanus* appears to be a non-monophyletic genus.

- 40(39). Male with last abdominal segment not entirely covered by elytra; elytra in both sexes with moderately narrow, well-defined, oblique yellowish pubescent band on basal half from humerus to suture (Figs. 14–15) *Graphisurus* Kirby, 1837 (part)
- Male with last abdominal segment covered by elytra; elytra in both sexes lacking well-defined oblique yellowish pubescent band on basal half (Fig. 4) *Antecurisa* Gilmour, 1960
