BARBARA LIS & JERZY A. LIS (2021) *Hypsipyrgias joseliae*, a new species of lace bugs (Heteroptera: Tingidae: Tinginae) from New Guinea with a key to species of the genus *Hypsipyrgias*, and comments on three allied genera *Hypsipyrgias* Kirkaldy, 1908, *Diplocysta* Horváth, 1925, and *Hypsotingis* Drake, 1960. *Zootaxa*, 4958: 327–333.

Please note that the new name of species was proposed with multiple original spellings. The incorrect original spelling “*joseliae*” occurs six times in the paper, including the title, the abstract, the species header, and the key to species, whereas the correct original spelling (“*joceliae*”) only one time (a legend to fig. 7).

Although Art. 32.5 of the ICZN makes it clear that the correct original spelling should be “*joceliae*” and not “*jose-liae*”, we decided to publish an explicit erratum stating the correct name of the species (*joceliae*).
