At the beginning of page 382, in the second sentence:

"However, for the suprageneric classification of Gymnophthalmidae we preferred the proposal of major clades as subfamilies (Pyron et al. 2013; Colli et al. 2015) rather than tribes (Goicoechea et al. 2016), since tribes classification has low phylogenetic support, except for those proposed within the <u>Cercosaurinae</u> clade, which are consistently recovered in different studies."

The word here we highlight in bold should be Gymnophthalminae, since the paragraph refers to the Gymnophthalmini, Heterodactylini, and Iphisini.
