## WOJCIECH NIEDBAŁA & WOJCIECH Ł. MAGOWSKI (2024) New species of ptyctimous mites (Acari, Oribatida) from Peruvian Andes. *Zootaxa*, 5448 (3): 401–416.

The publication by Niedbała & Magowski 2024 contains following nomenclatoral errors in need of correction which are listed below.

- 1. The spelling of the species name "andensis" of the genus Mesotritia (page 401) is unintended misnomer, and should be reverted to the primarily conceived form "andina" (as used on pages 402, 404, 405 and 414). The word "andensis" is grammatically and nomenclaturally correct (and in a form recommended by ICZN document "Formation of names" (https://www.iczn.org/the-code/formation-of-names/) nevertheless not intended by authors as less euphonius than "andina".
- 2. The spelling of the species name "cochamarcuensis" of the genus Austrophthiracarus (pages 402 and 414) is erroneous (lapsus calami) and should be reverted to the correct form "conchamarcensis" (as used on pages 401, 406, 407 and 415).
- 3. The spelling of the species name "churubambuensis" of the genus Notophthiracarus (pages 402 and 414) is erroneous (lapsus calami) and should be reverted to the correct form "churubambensis" (as used on pages 401, 409, 410 and 415).
