On page 545, the heading “*Eustrophinus bombinus* (Seidlitz, 1898)” in the Checklist of *Eustrophopsis* species for Brazil should be updated and replaced with “*Eustrophopsis ochracea* (Motschulsky 1872)”. The revised section should read:
