We have identified three typographical errors in Table 1 affecting standard length (SL) values for the following specimens:

VIMS 45856: published as 136 mm; correct value 132.7 mm

OS 26108: published as 133 mm; correct value 124.5 mm

OS 26109: published as 133 mm; correct value 131.9 mm

We have confirmed that all analyses and associated calculations used the correct SL values, and that the issue is restricted to Table 1 only; therefore, the correction does not affect the results, interpretations, or conclusions of the paper.
